



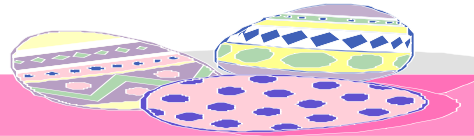

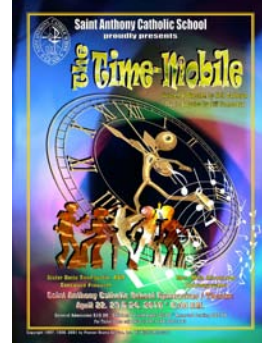


"The Time-Mobile"
