



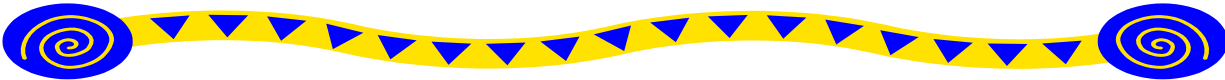

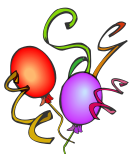

Reminders on the "Uniform Policy"!

The school uniform should always be worn with pride and dignity. Students must conduct themselves with proper decorum **on or off-campus**. The uniform **BOYS POLO SHIRT** and **GIRLS BLOUSES MUST** be neatly tucked in at all times. The uniform **SHORTS** must be knee-length. **TROUSERS and SHORTS MUST** be worn at the waistline (not lower). **ONLY SACS** jackets are allowed, should the student desire to wear one.

Students with improper school uniform and/or improper wear of the school uniform are sent to the Main Office. Repeated failure to comply with uniform code calls for disciplinary action.

BOYS (Kindergarten to 8th grade)

Boys have the option of wearing trousers or shorts from Monday through Friday. All boys **MUST have at least ONE PAIR of trousers** for Special Occasions/Masses

Shorts: Navy blue, embroidered logo and knee length
Trousers: Navy blue, embroidered logo and 1" below ankle length
Belt: Must be Navy blue or Black
(everyone MUST wear a belt)
Polo Shirt: White short sleeved with embroidery logo on pocket
Undershirt: Plain white short sleeved (no colored undershirts)
Socks: Plain white crew socks
(to wear with Shorts or Trousers-NO LOGOS)
Shoes: Plain black shoes
(may be sneaker type-so long as it is all black)
NO LOGOS, No high tops, No Heelies
P.E. Gym shoes: Any gym sneaker type shoes (non-marking soles)
P.E. attire: Blue shorts/white T-shirts with mascot logo

For all Kindergarten to 8th grade SPIRIT WEAR!!

Spirit Day: **Optional on Fridays ONLY**
(maybe subject to change by announcement)
Shirt: Spirit T-shirt (sold strictly by PTO)
Jeans: Straight leg PLAIN jeans in dark blue or light blue
(NO CARPENTER TYPE JEANS, NO BAGGY JEANS, DESIGNER JEANS OR EMBROIDERY JEANS)

GIRLS (Kinder to 5th grade)

Jumper: Blue and White checkered jumper with embroidered logo
Blouse: White buttoned down, 3/4" sleeve length
Socks: Plain white crew socks ONLY (NO LOGOS, LACEY types)
Shoes: Plain black shoe
(may be sneaker type-so long as it is all black)
NO BALLERINA TYPE SHOES, NO LOGOS,
Shoe heel: Not to be more than 1/2" sole
P. E. Gym shoes: Any gym sneaker type shoes (non-marking soles)
P.E. attire: Blue shorts/white T-shirts with mascot logo

GIRLS (6th to 8th)

Shorts: Shorts with embroidery logo (must be worn knee length)
Blouse: White buttoned down, 3/4" sleeve length
Tie: Navy blue with embroidery logo
(SOLD AT ROYAL BICS ONLY)
Socks: Plain white crew socks (NO LOGOS, LACEY types)
Shoes: Plain black shoes
(may be sneaker type-so long as it is all black)
NO BALLERINA TYPE SHOES, NO LOGOS
Shoe heel: Not to be more than 1/2" sole
P.E. Gym shoes: Any gym sneaker type shoes (non-marking soles)
P.E. attire: Blue shorts/white T-shirts with mascot logo
