

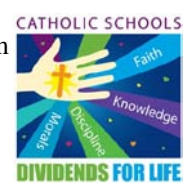

Hence, please be reminded that the 2010/2011 SY Returning Student Registration packets will be sent out to the youngest or only student when we return after the Christmas Break.

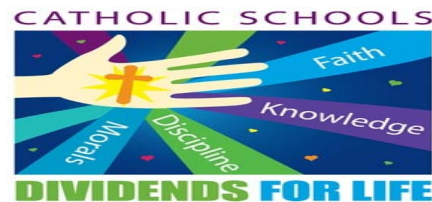

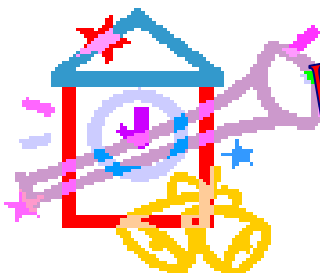
