Welcome to a new school year! We look forward to an exciting year for our school family. SACS Rainbows Program will be celebrating its tenth year of the re-introduction of the program to the school curriculum. Ten years ago we began servicing 21 students and have grown to 59 students in SY 2011 with 15 returning students.

The Rainbows program is a support group for students experiencing a loss or change in the family unit. It is not a counseling program. The school has a counselor who assist the students outside the program. Students meet weekly with trained teachers to facilitate interaction through listening and sharing their thoughts, feelings and experiences while learning coping skills through the curriculum. Meetings are held during their lunch period and no class time is used to disrupt their academic schedule.

A Confidentiality Contract is signed by all students and teachers to ensure that privacy is honored by the children and teachers during group sessions.

We invite you to consider registering your child or children if you feel that this program can help your child deal with any change in the family unit that may be affecting him or her. Registration will begin in September and the sessions will begin in October. Please see your child's homeroom teacher or come to the MAIN OFFICE to pick up a registration form.
