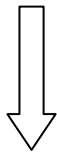

## 2011/2012 SY Registration

Monday, January 3, 2011 is the date set for distribution of the upcoming 2011/2012 Returning Student Registration packets. We ask that you register your child/children as soon as possible so that they may be assured their slot for the coming year. In addition, please be advised that the deadline to register will be on Monday, February 28, 2011.

Outside enrollment has been in great demand and we would hate for our returning students to lose their slots because of failure to meet the deadline.

Those students who miss the deadline will be placed on a waiting list. Registration forms WILL NOT BE accepted unless FULL payment of Registration fee, PTO fee and Book fees are included.

Parents/guardians are encouraged to start making small payments once forms are received, however, make sure that you make all necessary payments in full by the deadline.
