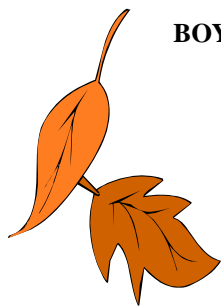
## Tuition Reminder

## Campus Safety

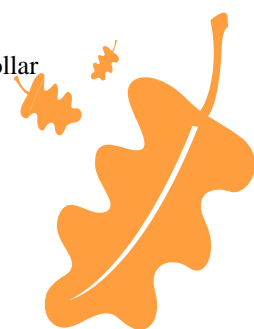

Plain **WHITE** socks, **NO low cut socks allowed**, Plain **BLACK** shoes,  
Navy or Black belt-all boys **MUST** wear a belt

**GIRLS:** Hair **MUST** be appropriately styled/cut to keep from covering face  
**SIMPLE HAIR TIES** and **PLAIN HEADBANDS** allowed  
**NO FLORAL** (large or small) hair accessories allowed  
No spiking, highlighting or coloring of hair other than natural hair color.  
Plain **WHITE** socks, **NO low cut socks allowed**, Plain **BLACK** shoes –  
**NO BALLERINA TYPE SHOES**
