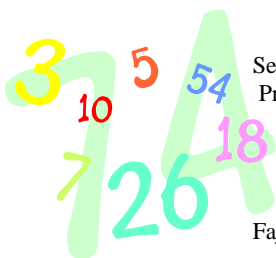
Math Olympiads
